ACCREDITATION OF TRAINERS IN ACCORDANCE WITH TVET ACT 2013

The Technical and Vocational Education and Training Authority (TVETA) is a public corporate agency established under the Technical and Vocational Education and Training (TVET) Act No. 29 of 2013 to regulate and coordinate training in the country. In implementing its mandate as stipulated in section 7 and for purposes of improving its service delivery to its clients with regard to section 17 and 23(3) of the TVET Act 2013 on application for registration and licensing of TVET institutions and trainers respectively, TVETA has launched an online TVET MIS that will facilitate submission of online applications.

This is therefore, to bring to your attention that trainers can now comfortably make applications and track the status of their application on their mobile devices or computers without calling or visiting TVETA offices. Individuals can apply for licensing as a TVET trainer/assessor and verifier and must do so by 30th June, 2020. The TVET MIS can be accessed by logging on to TVETA MIS link mis.tveta.go.ke and apply.

Those who may have not applied and/or licensed by then will be considered non-compliant hence ineligible to train or serve as assessors or verifiers in the TVET sector.

You are therefore required to bring the contents of this circular to all trainers under your purview to enable them to comply accordingly.
